## Free shuttle bus over the weekend of: 15-16-17 April; 22-23 April; 29-30 April - 1 May 2017

Vlasmarktdreef will be closed on these days from Nijvelsesteenweg. Parking 2, 3 and 8 can not be reached by car. Except from 9 am to 8 pm for groups coming by coach, and for drivers who have an identity document for the disabled.

The city of Halle provides a shuttle bus from 9 am to 8 pm. This bus takes you **for free** from Halle to the wild daffodils (P8 Achtdreven). It has two pick-up points: **at the station** of Halle and at the **end of the Welkomstlaan**.

The first bus leaves at 9 am from the station. After that it comes every 30 minutes. There are 85 places on the bus.


You can park your car along the Welkomstlaan.

To return to Halle by shuttle bus: pick-up point **in Hallerbos in car park 8**. The first bus leaves at 9.15 am, afterwards every 30 minutes. The last bus leaves from the wood at 7.45 pm.

## If you come by car to the forest


It is recommended to use **car park 1 Hogebermweg**, especially at the weekends. Also **Houtveld** can be used as a car park on busy days, except on Saturday 22 April when Houtveld is closed as the 'Bluebell jogging' starts from there.

Via Exit 21 on the R0

• Ring R0 (E19 Brussels-Mons) Exit 21 (Halle)

at the exit, keep to the left • turn left at the second traffic lights (N28-Nivelles) • for car park Hogebermweg (P1 on the map): turn left at the junction Warande/Maasdal, following the sign post 'P Hallerbos', turn right immediately after the bridge over the motorway– gps: N 50.71360 – E 4.26721.
for Houtveld: turn left at the junction Warande/Maasdal, following the sign post 'P Hallerbos', then take the second street on the right (Kasteelstraat). Continue as far as possible until the junction with Pipaenshoek. Parking on the Houtveld – gps: N 50.70810 – E 4.26497. Walk to the forest via Pipaenshoek and the wildlife tunnel.

In the three weekends with the shuttle bus, horse riders can not park their trailer on car park 2, 3 or 8. An alternative is car park 1. From 15 April to 1 May, trailers can not be parked on car park 8 during the week as well, as car park 8 is the place where the buses will turn.
